B. Throop and A. J. Hayward County Commissioners. dated the 24th day of January 1846.

At a meeting of the County Commissioners Court of Montgomery County, begun and held at the Court house in Woodstock in said County, on Monday the second day of March A.D. 1846.

Ordered by the Court that the petition of divers citizens of said County for the location of a road, beginning at the East end of the tamarack bridge on section 30 in Township forty six North of Range Eight East of the principal Meridian on the Delviden and South fork road and running as near a practicable on the line of the old survey of said road if it being in a state of repair now, to the State road leading from Montgomery to the State line, thence southerly on the said State road to the South line of Rufus C. McIntosh land thence east on his South line and Robert Stockton South line to his South East corner and thence to the West end of White Trees in the village of Solon be accepted and that Rufus McIntosh, Phillips D. Public and Alden Ransper be appointed views on said road. And it is further ordered that the petitioners pay the expense of said location.

Ordered by the Court that the petition of divers citizens of said County for the vacation of so much of the Southfork and Delviden road, as lies East of the tamarack Swamp and West of English Prairie be accepted; and that Samuel Sheppard, Sylvester Nelson and Isaac Smith be appointed views to examine and report upon said road. And it is further ordered that the petitioners pay all expenses of said examination.

Goran, Charles W. Goodrich and John P. Pein be appointed view to locate said road and it is further ordered that the petitioners pay the expense of said location.

Ordered by the Court that the petition of divers Citizens of said County for the location of a road commencing at the road leading from Crystal Lake to Woodstock as a point near or on the line between Walter Jewetts & Jacob Clinch thence to John McKens thence to William Lanson, thence to intersect the road from Crystal Lake to Orman or or near Mr Kibbey near the South line said County on the marsh and best ground be accepted and that James Lanson, William Lanson and Ben F. Bright be appointed view of said road and that the petitioners pay the expenses of locating said road.

Ordered by the Court that the petition of divers citizens of said County for the location of a road commencing at Richmond at Main Street running on the Section line between 9 & 16. thence through by John W. McKles Middle fence to the South West quarter of Section 14 thence West on the north line of the two South forty's to intersect the road running north and South be accepted and that William Raymond Elden Ransom and Nathan Coyne be appointed view on said road and it is further ordered that the petitioners pay all the expenses of locating said road.

Ordered by the Court that the plan and profile of a road as located by Ben C. Couch and Stephen Ransom be accepted upon condition that the petitioners pay all the expenses of opening said road.

Ordered by the Court that the petition of divers Citizens of said County for the location of a road in Township 46 north Range 7 commencing at the South East corner of Section fourteen road running west on the Section line to the South West corner of Section 15 thence be accepted and that Wm. Deun, John Ransom and Peter Hoag be appointed view on said road and it is further ordered that the petitioners pay all the expenses of said location.

Ordered by the Court that the petition of divers Citizens of said County for the location of a road commencing at the State road on Garden Prairie near Marcus Whites and running north till it intersects the road running from Belvidere to Bigfoot prairie at the School house near Edwarda Sterngsons on the prairie be accepted and that Charles Jackson Amos A. Jackson and Nathan Jackson be appointed view on said road and it is further ordered that the petitioners pay all expenses of locating said road.

Ordered by the Court that the petition of said County for the view of a road commencing at said Martins Kellys and view for miles of said road and that honorably be accepted and that Helen Ramsdell Luiko Helborn and Ira C. Haight be appointed view on said road and it is further ordered that the petitioners pay the expense of locating.

Ordered by the Court that the petition of divers Citizens for the location of a road commencing on the State road at the Quarter stake on the South side of Section nine T. 45 N. Range 5. E. and running thence north three fourths of a mile to the north West corner of William Morse field thence East to intersect with the Cheamy road near Robert Walton be accepted and that Robert Latham Watson R. Heath and Thomas Finney be appointed to view and locate the same and it is further ordered that the petitioners pay all the expenses of locating said road.

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Ordered by the Court that the petition of divers Citizens of said County for a review of so much of the road running from the Rushwaukee bridge to Seawards Mill commencing at the above bridge and running west ^{west} four miles be accepted and that R. A. Hutchinson and J. Blair and D. Hutchinson be appointed viewers on said road and it is further ordered that the petitioners pay all expenses of locating.

And now come Juggil St. Whipple and moved the Court for an appeal from the judgement of this Court in relation to the petition presented by Frank Reed and others for the locating of a road then named which was granted upon his entering into bond in the sum of two hundred dollars with Dexter Parsons as security and thereupon the said Whipple presented to said Court a bond executed as aforesaid which said bond approved by said Court and said approval ordered to be entered of Record.

Ordered by the Court that the petition of divers Citizens of said County for the relocation of so much of the road leading from Chicago to Madison as lies between Alden Post Office on Section fifteen in Township forty five North Range five East of the third principal Meridian be accepted and that J. A. Hutchinson and D. Hutchinson and J. Blair Sr. be appointed viewers on said road and the petitioners pay all the expense of locating the same.

Ordered by the Court that the petition of divers Citizens of said County praying for the review of so much of a road leading from the bridge across Fox River at McHenry to Griswold's barn as is included between the slough on the land of S. S. Church and the corners of Sections one and twelve in Twp 44 N. R. 8 E. and the corner of S. 16 N. 44 N. R. 9 E. of the 3^d p. M. be accepted and that Michael Sutton James Gibb and Amos Clark be appointed viewers and it is further ordered that the petitioners pay all the expenses of reviewing.

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Ordered by the Court that the petition of divers Citizens of said County praying for viewers to view and locate a County road to commence in the centre of the Geneva Lake and Dundee road 1/4 mile south of the South quarter stake on Township line Section 35 T. 44 N. R. 6 E. being the South west corner of lands now owned by P. M. Ditz to run South easterly to intersect the Pleasant Grove and Dundee road at or near the Millers be accepted and that Christopher Maltrap Alvin Shield and Peter Sta Dow be appointed viewers and it is further ordered that the petitioners pay all the expenses of reviewing.

Ordered by the Court that the petition of divers Citizens of said County for a review of so much of a County road as lies between the N. W. corner of the N. 1/2 of the S. E. quarter of section No. 17 owned by J. Garret and Dennis Ridders house and if the same shall be deemed useless and burthensome by the viewers (as said petitioners think it will be) that it may be relocated so as to run South from the first point mentioned until it strikes the centre of S. No. 20 thence E until it intersects the road as it is now laid be accepted and that Orry Barrett Simson Bellows and George Ward be appointed viewers and that the petitioners pay all the expenses of reviewing.

Ordered by the Court that the petition of divers Citizens of said County to view and locate a road leading or commencing at the point on the road leading from Woodstock to McHenry where the W line of land owned by Asa Churchills crosses said road thence N. on the parallel lines of lots (by Government survey) as near as may be feasible intersecting the road leading from Joseph Kenipshalls to Boon Mill be accepted and that Glyman E. Baird William J. Rider and James S. Murphy be appointed viewers and that the petitioners pay all the expenses of reviewing.

Ordered by the Court that the petition of divers Citizens of said County representing that the interests of the public would be greatly promoted by having a grant for the laying of the following road commencing at or near the N. E. corner of Jesse D. Millers farm thence running E on the 1/2 mile line to or near to Fox River at the N. E. corner of M. A. Soomis land thence on the nearest best and most practicable route to intersect a road laid by order of McHenry Co at the N. E. corner of Section 31 T. 43 N. R. 9 E. thence following said road to the bridge crossing Kinch's creek thence on the most practicable route to the line dividing the county of Lake and McHenry be accepted and that Jesse D. Miller M. A. Soomis and Floyd Johnson be appointed viewers and that the petitioners pay all the expenses of reviewing.

Upon motion of Charles Hunt it is ordered, and considered by the Court that an order heretofore made at the December term of this Court in relation to the damages assessed upon the road between E. W. Bingham and Philip Sperry, by James Stewart Esq. M. Case and J. T. Siddings be and the same is hereby rescinded it appearing to the satisfaction of the Court that said damages was illegally assessed and reported.

Ordered by the Court that the report of J. Colby Esq. of a fine assessed against John Koney be accepted.

Ordered by the Court that the report of Mustoe B. Given of a fine assessed against Patrick Koney be accepted.

Ordered by the Court that the plat and profile of a road as located by H. Cornick and Wm. S. Cobb and Lewis Brown Esq. be accepted, upon condition that the petitioners pay the expenses of opening said road. Said road to be laid out four rods wide.

Ordered by the Court that the plat and profile of a road as located by J. M. Topp and Peter La. Gou two of the petitioners be accepted upon condition that the petitioners pay the expense of opening the same and hereupon said road to be laid out four rods wide.

Ordered by the Court that the report of M. F. J. School Commissioners of said County be accepted.

Ordered by the Court that the plat and profile of a road as located and attempted by Thayer Howard Samuel Garrett and John Johnson be accepted upon condition that the petitioners pay the expense of locating and opening the same. Said road to be laid out four rods wide.

Ordered by the Court that the petition of divers Citizens of said County for the location of a road commencing at the Section Corner standing on the South side of sections 3 & 4 in Township No. forty five Range Seven East thence a westerly course on or near the Section line until it intersects the road leading from My Bunk to Hill Corners be accepted, and that Jacob Lurier Andrew Colozon and William Doornis be appointed appraisers of said road and it is further ordered that the petitioners pay the expense of locating the same.

Ordered by the Court that the petition of divers Citizens of said County for the location of a road to commence at the termination of a road passing the residence of Gustavus J. Palmer thence in an easterly direction in the nearest and best route until it intersects the McCollum Road road or near the residence of Charles Patterson be accepted, and that William Huffman Russell Stanton and Gustavus A. Palmer, be appointed appraisers on said said road, and it is further ordered that the petitioners pay the expense of locating.

Shepard Ella Harris and Samuel J. Foster be appointed viewers on said road and that the petitioners pay the expenses of locating.

Ordered by the Court that the petition of divers Citizens of said County for the location of a road from the South West corner of James Thomsons farm to the extremity of the County of the road running from Glen to the mouth of the Spessant, be accepted and that S. H. Stilson James Thomson and Miles Ole be appointed viewers and it is further ordered that the petitioners pay the expense of said examination.

Ordered that Court adjourn until tomorrow morning at eight o'clock A.M. Court met pursuant to adjournment.

Ordered by the Court that the petition of divers Citizens of said County for the location of a road commencing near the South West corner of Joseph Healy field thence in a westerly direction to Jacob Kest from thence to the bridge near Hill Connellys, be accepted and that Amos Boyce Joseph Healy and Hill Connelly be appointed viewers, and it is further ordered that the petitioners pay the expense of locating the same.

Ordered by the Court that the petition of divers Citizens of said County for the repair and relocation of a road commencing at or near Dawson Saw Mill on the Chicago road thence running up the Hill in an ^{North Eastern} direction to the Edwards house be accepted and that S. M. Thomas Francis Crane and Chumey Chapman be appointed viewers on said road and it is further ordered that the petitioners pay the expenses of locating the same.

Ordered by the Court that the plat and profile of a road as returned by H. Carmichael, Wm S. Robbe and Peter Brown be accepted upon condition that the petitioners pay the expense of opening the same. Said road to be laid out three rods in width.

This day came into Court Lyman Burr and presented the receipt of the damages assessed by Jesse Slagys Nelson Scott and Thomas Townsend that Mr. Mills would sustain by reason of the location of a road through land owned by the said Mills, from Woodstock to the Colman bridge. It is therefore ordered that said receipt be accepted and that said road be opened in pursuance of law.

And now come Amos Bloor and presented the plat and profile of a road as received by D. W. Jones and Peter, Jos. Dow, viewers appointed at the last term of this Court, to widen and relocate the Dundee road on the South side of Pleasant Grove, and moved the Court to accept said report, and thereupon came Benjamin N. Johnson and others by Wm Sloan their Attorney, and resisted said motion, and entered a cross motion to reject the same, and the Court being fully advised in the premises sustained the motion of the said Amos Bloor and accepted said plat and profile, and thereupon the said Benjamin N. Johnson and others their attorney moved the Court for an appeal being to the Circuit Court of said McHenry County, which it granted upon condition that the said Benjamin N. Johnson enter into Bond conditioned according to law with good and sufficient security in the sum of two hundred dollars, and thereupon the said Benjamin N. Johnson filed his said bond which is accepted and approved by the Court.

Now come Benjamin N. Johnson and others by William Sloan their atty, and moved the Court on affidavit filed herein to grant a new hearing on the petition for a review of the Dundee road on the South side of Pleasant Grove as his west of the east line of the North East quarter of Section four Township forty three Range five East so as to run north, on or near the line of Warren Blakesley and Christobers Spontinables to the State road or in any other place excepting where it now and is legally located filed herein at the last term of the Court and on the remonstrance against said petition and move the Court to rescind the order appointing viewers to review said road and the Court being fully advised therein adjudged and ordered that said motion be overruled, and thereupon said Benjamin N. Johnson

and others by Wm Sloan their atty pray this Court to grant them an appeal from the said Judgment and order of this Court to the McHenry County Circuit Court and said appeal is granted them
